Directions:

From 285:

- Take 285 to 75N.
- Take 75N to Exit 278 (Glade Rd).
- Make a Left onto Glade Rd (Cherokee St).
- Turn right onto Lake Acworth (Hwy 92).
- Turn right onto Dallas Rd. ramp (first right after overpass) – Look for Brown sign.
- Turn left on Main Street.
- Turn left on Lakewood Drive (2 streets)
- Turn right at 4864 Lakewood Drive (by the 3rd streetlight) - look for ASHC banner on mailbox. If you go to the lake, you have gone too far.

From Barrett Pkwy:

- Take Barrett Pkwy (heading towards Town Center Mall).
- Turn left on Cobb Pkwy.
- Turn right on Lake Acworth (Hw 92).
- Turn right onto Dallas Rd ramp (look for library sign).
- Turn left on Main Street (go under overpass).
- Turn left on Lakewood Drive (2 streets)
- Turn right at 4864 Lakewood Drive (by the 3rd streetlight) - look for ASHC banner on mailbox. If you go to the lake, you have gone too far.
