Details: Come one, come all, to the second ASHC Funny Video Clip Party! We had such a good time at the first video clip party two years ago, we decided to do it again. We will be having a contest to see who can bring the funniest movie scene. For example, who can forget the pool scene in *Caddyshack* or the "I'll have what she's having" scene in *When Harry Met Sally*. Laugh with your ASHC friends as we compete to see who can bring in the funniest video clip.

To compete in the contest you need to bring a humorous video clip from a movie or TV show. The clip must be 5 minutes or less in duration. **Our strong preference will be for VHS tapes.** You should bring the tape **cued up to the scene you want to show.** That way, we just pop the movie tape in and hit play. Call Dale with any questions about cueing your clip. For additional instructions, including what to do if you only have the clip on DVD, see the attached FAQ page.

The party will start at 7:00 PM. Everyone is welcome to attend the party, regardless of whether or not you enter the contest. We will conduct registration at the beginning of the party. The contest will begin at 8:00 PM sharp. If you are "fashionably late", that's fine but you may miss some very funny and classic scenes. All spectators will be given a chance to be a judge. All judges will be given a list of the contestants, entry titles and a pencil. We will count the ballots to determine the contest winner. The winner will be awarded a prize of \$50.

Note: This is an after-dinner party. There will not be a meal served per se, but there will be plenty of popcorn and soft drinks. There will also be movie candy available. All for the low and very reasonable price of our standard house party fee: \$6.00 for members, \$8.00 non-members, prospects free; BYOB

Register Your Entry in Advance

Please register your entry in advance with the contest coordinator, Dale J. Giddens (770-995-7264, dalejgiddens@bellsouth.net). That will prevent multiple contestants having the same entry idea. That will also allow us to pre-print the ballots in advance. There will be a few blank spots at the end of the ballot for late entries. We promise not to steal your idea. Advance registration will help tremendously with the organization of the contest. Please make every effort to register in advance. If you register in advance, but can't make it because of a last-minute emergency, it won't cost you anything except you won't win the contest. Make sure to label all entries so they can be returned to the proper owner.

When you call or e-mail Dale with your pre-registration information, he needs to know the following things:

- Your Name
- Movie or Show Title
- Media Type (i.e. VHS, DVD)
- Start Time of the Scene (in minutes and seconds)

FAQ's:

Q: Why is VHS preferably to DVD? What if I only have the scene I want to show on DVD?

A: DVD movies take a lot longer to set up each time. Some DVD's lock out all the special commands until the previews and FBI warnings are shown. This can take 5 to 10 minutes. In other words, our audience will have to sit through several minutes of boring stuff if you bring a DVD.

If you only have the clip available on DVD, please contact Dale in advance. Dale has hundreds of movies on VHS. If he doesn't have it on VHS, he may be able to dub it to VHS for you. He has a huge DVD collection. If necessary, Dale might even rent the movie on VHS to make things go smoother.

While our strong preference will be for VHS tapes, DVD entries will be allowed (as a last resort). Please make a note of the time in the movie at which the funny scene occurs (in minutes and seconds). For example, if the scene occurs at 25 minutes and 20 seconds into the movie we need to know that in advance. We will be showing all of the DVD entries last.

Q: What if my entry is only 15 seconds long?

A: That's fine. The clip can be as short as you want. It just can't be over 5 minutes in length. We hope to have lots of entries, so time is definitely a factor.

Q: What if I don't own the scene I want to show?

A: The contest coordinator (Dale J. Giddens) 770-995-7264 has hundreds of movies on VHS and DVD. Just ask, and if he doesn't have it, he may be able to borrow it. Again, the big preference is VHS tape. It is much easier to cue up and play.

Q: What if I don't have an entry idea?

A: The contest coordinator will be more than happy to help you out.

Q: What kind of things will get you disqualified?

A: We will only accept VHS entries that are already cued up to the scene on the tape and ready to show. We will only accept DVD's as a last resort and if you know the exact time the scene starts. Sadly, for the purposes of this party, we don't have time to watch the whole movie. Because this is a mixed group of people of various ages and gender, please do not bring anything that is explicitly pornographic or offensive. Please don't bring any amateur home movies.

Q: What if we have several people wanting to show the same scene?

A: If the contest coordinator is aware of this problem in advance, he can suggest alternatives. Otherwise, we may have a situation where the prize money may have to be split. The same clip will not be shown more than once. The credit will be shared if two people have the same idea.

Q: What if I don't want to compete?

A: Fine, we'll be happy to have you anyway.

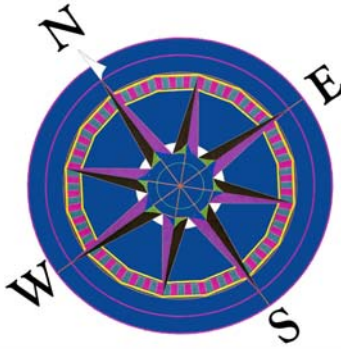
Q: Where do I get ideas?

A: There are literally thousands of movies out there. A friend of mine told me today about a classic line from a Bob Hope movie made over 40 years ago. It was brilliant! If you are not a movie buff, chances are you know someone who is.

Q: Can I submit more than one entry?

A: Depending on how many contestants there are, we may allow more than one entry per contestant. That decision will be made the night of the party, after the registration process is complete.

Directions:

- Take 285 to 85N.
- You will pass the Jimmy Carter, Indian Trail, Beaver Ruin and Pleasant Hill exits.
- Take the Hwy 316 exit heading towards Athens.
- On Hwy 316, you will pass the Sugarloaf, Riverside and Hwy 120 exits.
- You will pass a Ford Dealership on the right and a Pontiac/GMC dealership on the left.
- Take a left at the stoplight at the next intersection, Collins Hill Road.
- Zero your trip odometer.
- You will go straight through a traffic light at the Perimeter University Entrance and keep going down hill.
- As you start heading back uphill, you will pass an Athletic (Tennis) club on the left and a Christmas Tree Farm on the right.
- At 1.4 miles (from the Collins Hill intersection) you will see a brick wall on the right with the entrance for Bentrige, Timber Glen and Timber Crossing subdivisions.
- Turn into the subdivision.
- Drive down Bentrige Court for a very short distance and take the first left onto Bentrige Drive.
- Go up the hill and down the straight street (you will pass over 3 speed humps).
- Turn left at the stop sign and go down Glenfield Drive.
- Go down a couple of streets and turn right onto Glenview Way.
- Go to the bottom of the hill.
- The street makes a gradual turn to the left and as it heads back uphill Dale's house is on the left.
- It is a beige house with white trim. There is a large stone mailbox out front with the numbers 152 on it.
