Directions:

Horizon is located at the corner of Euclid & Austin Aves. (Little Five Points) in a beige brick renovated historic school building.

- From **I-85/I-75** take the 248C Freedom Parkway exit east.
- You will veer to the right at the Carter Center (via the 42 Connector).
- When you dead-end at Moreland Avenue, make a right.
- At the third light, make a right onto Euclid Avenue (please note: as Euclid crosses Moreland it becomes McLendon).
- Then go through the second light (crossing Austin Avenue).
- Their free parking is accessible via the first driveway on your left. Continue driving behind the building until you reach the large gravel lot.
